Aged for at least two years.

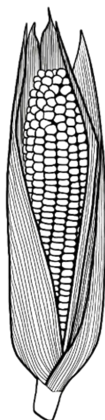
Aging takes place in new charred oak barrels.

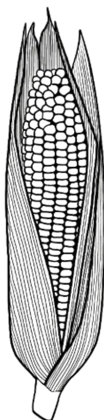

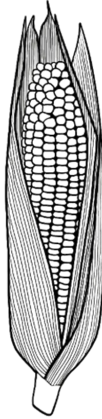

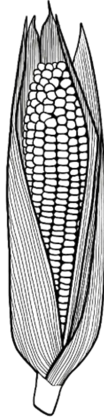

## AMERICAN SINGLE MALT

Must be 100% malted barley & no less than 80 proof.

Be distilled entirely in one United States Distillery

Be matured in oak barrels that hold no more than 700 Liters.

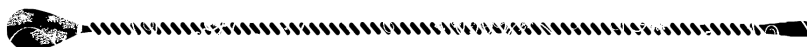

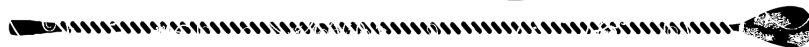

Aged for at least three years in Japan.

Water used for production must be extracted in Japan.

Must be bottled at no less than 80 proof.

Many Japanese whiskeys have flavors similar to Scotch, this is because the first distilleries to make whiskey in Japan utilized Scotch production practices, mash bills, & even Scottish Coffey stills.

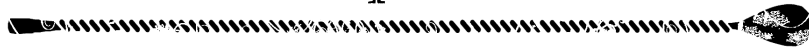

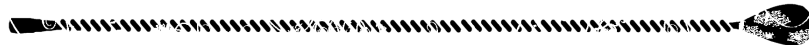

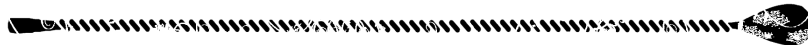
